

For Special Circumstances

- Urge vendors who have their own meters to conserve water.
- Used cistern to capture rainwater for irrigation.
- Irrigation of the university football field has been limited to one time per seven-day period, scheduled between 3 and 5 AM to minimize loss by evaporation.
- Stopped all outdoor dust control application of water.
- All water to be used for watering horse rings will come from retention ponds.
- Wash down the holding area prior to the milking parlor once a day rather than after each milking where possible.
- Hoses have been removed from all exterior hose bibs and the faucet knobs removed or the hose bib shut off at an interior valve where possible.
- Wash down the exit ramp from the milking parlor every other day.
- Water wagon to water annuals and valuable greenhouse plants.
- Water down riding rings with water truck only when necessary.
- At swine units cut back on washing floors, washing only when essential.
- When mixing pesticides, avoid mixing any overage and continue to scout crops to determine threshold levels for pests to eliminate the use of preventative sprays.
- Repair or replacement of livestock watering troughs.
- Hand flush livestock facilities where possible rather than flush.
- Monitoring indoor pool make-up water to eliminate waste.
- Where possible at historic sites and museums, control and filter storm water runoff and direct storm water to retention basins.
